STUDENT ID BADGES

Beginning 11-15-21 students will be expected to have an ID badge on at all times. If a student forgets his/her badge, GMS will create a "visitor" badge for the student. On the third, request for a visitor badge, the student will be expected to purchase a new ID for \$5. If an ID badge is lost, a replacement badge is \$5.

LUNCHES

Beginning 11-15-21, students will only receive one free lunch tray. All additional items will need to be purchased. Money may be put in student accounts or students will need to bring cash. Students will swipe their ID badges during lunch to document the free lunch tray.

Thank you so much for giving your time to help our campus be even more successful! Your partnership with us is so valuable. All of our students benefit when we work together.

There are 3 lunches:

On all Block schedule days, A Days and B Days:

A lunch = 11:00 - 11:30 = 100% 6th grade students

B lunch = 11:50 - 12:20 = Mixed 7th and 8th grade students, but majority 7th

C lunch = 12:35 - 1:05 = Mixed 7th and 8th grade students, but majority 8th

On C days, Fridays - Notice the time differences:

A lunch = 10:50 - 11:20 = 100% 6th grade students

B lunch = 11:40 - 12:10 = Mixed 7th and 8th grade students, but majority 7th

C lunch = 12:30 - 1:00 = Mixed 7th and 8th grade students, but majority 8th

When you arrive, after you check in with the front office, please find an administrator or counselor (in the cafeteria or commons) who will let you know which location needs help. See tasks below based on location:

During your scheduled lunchtime volunteering, we would appreciate your help doing the following tasks in the CAFETERIA:

- · As students arrive at tables, remind them to sign the Seating Chart clipboards
- When tables are dismissed to the lunch line, please collect the seating charts by taking them off the clipboard and placing them on the cafeteria stage. FYI, sheets are color coded: A lunch = white, B lunch = blue, C lunch = green
- For the remainder of the time, please weave in and out among the tables and remind kids to pick up any
 food or trash on the floor, to stay seated unless they ask permission, and keep the shouting to a dull roar.
- If students raise their hands, please go see what they need. You may give them permission to use the
 restroom, get paper towels, get water/milk/utensils, and visit the Tiger Mart
- The administrator on duty will give directions on the microphone about when students are to throw away their garbage and when they are allowed to dismiss to class

During your scheduled lunchtime volunteering, we would appreciate your help doing the following tasks in the COMMONS:

- · As students arrive at tables, remind them to sign the Seating Chart clipboards
- When all the students at a table have completed their Seating charts, you can dismiss those who want a
 school lunch to go get in the lunch line. Please collect the seating charts by taking them off the clipboard
 and placing them on the cafeteria stage. FYI, sheets are color coded: A lunch = white, B lunch = blue, C lunch
 = green
- For the remainder of the time, please weave in and out among the tables and remind kids to pick up any
 food or trash on the floor, to stay seated unless they ask permission, and keep the shouting to a dull roar.
- If students raise their hands, please go see what they need. You may give them permission to use the
 restroom, get paper towels, get water/milk/utensils, visit the Tiger Mart
- . 10 min before they are dismissed, please go table to table to remind them to throw all trash away
- 5 min before they are dismissed remind them to wait until their table is inspected before they leave
- At dismissal time, you may let each table go after you have checked to see their table is clean

DROPPING OFF ITEMS AT SCHOOL

In order to assist students with self-responsibility and to keep classroom disruptions to a minimum, GMS does not make deliveries nor do we contact the student while they are in class to let them know that their item was dropped off. You may tell your student before school that you will be dropping off an item or you can email their teacher. The student will then have to pick it up from the front office. (delivery exceptions are contact lenses or glasses).

BOYS BASKETBALL TRYOUTS

All 7th and 8th-grade boys trying out for the '21-'22 basketball season need to sign up through the Google Form below. The form will close on Wednesday, Dec 1st.

The 7th grade will try out before school on Friday, Dec 3rd, and Dec 10th. Doors will open for 7th grade at 6:15 a.m. and tryouts will end at 8:00 a.m. on both days. 8th grade will try out on Thursday, Dec 2rd, and Friday, Dec 3rd immediately after school from 4:00 - 5:30 p.m. on both days.

Parents are responsible for dropping off and picking up their athlete. Please be on time.

In order to try out, each athlete must have a '21-'22 physical on the current AISD form (it must also be dated on or after April 15th, 2021), emergency card, and all online forms complete before tryouts. If an athlete tried out for football or soccer (or you already turned in all forms), all of this has already been taken care of, and he is set for the year. If not, please begin getting everything in order now to ensure participation in the tryout. If any forms are missing, your child will not be allowed to try out.

Green screens from the AISD App must be shown prior to each day of tryouts.

AFTER SCHOOL BEHAVIOR

The manager at Torchy's reached out and asked that concerns they are seeing be shared with the GMS

community. It appears that many of our GMS students are going to Torchy's afterschool unchaperoned. These students are vandalizing the restaurant. The manager is hoping that by sharing the concerns with our GMS families they won't have to implement any next steps. We are seeing some of the same behavior here at GMS; if students can be identified, parents will be contacted.

When we all work together we can support our students in all locations.

STUDENT ID'S

GMS issued student IDs last week. IDs will be required for all students, and will be used for checking out library books and Chromebook chargers; when lunch is no longer free, they will also be used to scan to pay for food. If lost, replacements can be requested in the office. The first replacement is free. Additional replacements will be \$5 each.

DRESSING OUT FOR PE

All Functional Fitness, P.E., and Strength & Conditioning students began dressing out last week. Students will use the locker room to change and store their belongings. A lock and locker will be provided. In addition to black athletic shorts/pants and appropriate shoes for physical activity, students are expected to wear the grey Gorzycki P.E. shirt. They are sold in the Tiger Mart (\$10 each).

PERMIT TO LEAVE SCHOOL EARLY

When students leave school early, written permission from a parent or guardian is required.

The student must bring the note to the front office in the morning to receive a pink slip.

The student will show the pink slip to the teacher when it is time to leave; the teacher will allow the student to go to the front office for parent pick-up. **Without a pink slip, students are not allowed to leave class**

Parent/guardian(s) must sign the student out in the front office before leaving campus. Please bring your photo ID.

ATTENDING GMS ATHLETIC EVENTS

AISD is allowing 100% capacity at all athletic events. GMS looks forward to the upcoming season and hopes that we can continue to provide a safe environment for all students, staff, and spectators. In order for us to do this, we need your assistance and cooperation for the benefit of our student-athletes. Please look over the guidelines below and help us provide the safest setting for our indoor athletic events.

- Complete the AISD App/Green screen prior to the game for each person attending. The Green Screen will not be checked upon entry.
- Masks are required for all spectators.

Families sit together socially distanced from others. Students may attend with a parent/guardian
and sit together as a family.

 The first game spectators exit immediately at the conclusion of the game allowing space for the second game.

RETURNING TO SCHOOL AFTER QUARANTINE AND/OR BEING SYMPTOMATIC

Quarantine: (For individuals that are NOT fully vaccinated)

Day 0 is the last date of exposure.

Day 1 is the first day without exposure.

Day 5-7 Covid testing can occur.

Day 8 the individual can return to campus if a negative test result is provided, and they have had no symptoms.

At this time, for someone who is quarantined and asymptomatic, we can accept a rapid test OR a PCR test from any testing facility that provides a paper document or email copy of the results. At-home tests are not accepted.

Any quarantined individual that develops symptoms, must have a negative PCR test and/or doctor's note to return before 10 days from the start of symptoms. Additionally, they must update the school, incase further contact tracing needs to be done.

Fully vaccinated individuals do not have to quarantine after a close contact exposure but should monitor for symptoms and if symptoms develop, they should notify the school nurse or administrators, go/stay home, and follow the same steps as quarantined individuals that develop symptoms (above).

Symptomatic / III students or staff (Regardless of vaccination status):

Symptomatic individuals (sent home from school sick, self-reported sick, or developed symptoms during quarantine) need a negative PCR Covid test and/or a doctor's note to return before 10 days. Please reference this quick guide from Student Health Services to know when to stay home and when/how to return: COVID 1pager 9-1-2021.pdf

Testing:

Staff or students who are symptomatic may request a rapid test on campus. However, rapid tests are not available for asymptomatic individuals at this time. With 1,272 students and 123 staff members, our one nurse is not able to provide peace-of-mind testing while still meeting the safety needs of those currently on campus daily. Our priority is to have our nurse available for those staff and students with an immediate need in the building.
