

NEW INFO FROM THE GORZYCKI HEALTH ROOM REGARDING END OF YEAR MEDICATION PICK UP

If your child has medication in the health room at school, please complete the attached document regarding how you want the medication returned. If you would like the medication sent home with your child, we need to have your permission in writing. All medications need to be picked up by the parent or sent home by the end of the last day of school with the student or it will be destroyed. No medications are allowed to remain at school over the summer. **NEW this year - All controlled substances must be picked up by a parent and cannot be sent home with the student.** For all other medications, please indicate below how you would like the medication returned by the last day of school and **return the attached form to the health room by 5/22/2023.** You may email the form to jessica.bram@austinisd.org or send it in with your student to the health room or front office.

PHYSICALS

Physicals for next school year will be passed out during P.E./Athletics classes on Friday (4/21). If a student is not in a P.E./Athletics class (or has a physical scheduled before Friday), please have them come by the gym to get a packet. Physicals are required for the following:

- Anyone trying out for a school sport next year
- Any student taking Strength and Conditioning class
- Dance teams (Tiger Drill, Tiger Dancers, Tigerettes)
- Cheerleaders
- Bowie Summer Performance Course (only current 6th graders and anyone who did not turn in a
 physical for this school year. Current 7th and 8th graders who turned in a physical this year do
 not need a new one for summer activities)

Any physical dated before April 15th, 2023, will not be accepted for next school year. The physical must be completed on the 2023-2024 AISD form, not on a physical form provided by the doctor. We cannot accept any emailed physicals or copies of the physical. It must be the original. I recommend making a

copy for your own records. In addition to the physical being handed in, there are also two online forms (available May 1) that must be completed before your student is eligible to participate.

STAAR TESTING SCHEDULE

STAAR exams are quickly approaching. Please see the information below to know when your student will be testing and the information for testing days. Unlike in the past, students will have all day to test if needed. Students who do not need extra time will return to their classes after 3 hours. We will send out the class schedule for testing weeks soon. Please note that the Friday of each testing week will be the make-up day for the subject tested that week.

- Thursday April 20: 6-8th grade Reading STAAR
- Wednesday April 26th: 8th grade Science STAAR
- Thursday April 27th: 8th grade Social Studies STAAR
- Tuesday May 2nd: Algebra I EOC exam
- Wednesday May 3rd: 6-8th Math STAAR

Testing Students Please Adhere To The Following Guidelines:

- *Please arrive at your usual time.
- *Name and room numbers will be posted in the commons and in grade level hallways
- *Students will be dismissed at 8:10am to go to their testing rooms.
- *Please bring a FULLY CHARGED District issued AISD Chromebook and charger
- *Bring a water bottle
- *Cell phones, smart watches, and backpacks will need to be placed in lockers before testing begins. Students will only need to bring their Chromebook, a book (non-electric), and water bottle to the testing room.

 The campus will be closed to all visitors on STAAR exam days and we highly recommend students <u>bring lunch</u> instead of buying it from the cafeteria if possible.

PROCESSES & PROCEDURES

QUICK GUIDE FOR PARENTS

The Quick Guide includes processes for: arrival and dismissal, reporting absences, dropping off items, and medications on campus.

ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL

Arrival: The building is open from 7:50 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The **Tardy Bell rings at 8:20**. Upon arrival, 6th grade students will report to the cafeteria. 7/8th grade students will report to the Commons. Students are to sit on the floor in the Cafeteria/Commons area. Students must be supervised in the building outside of school hours.

Dismissal:. Students who stay for an activity/tutoring session should remain in their designated area with the Gorzycki staff member in charge of the after school activity. Parents should pick up their child within 10 minutes of a given activity ending time. Failure to be picked up in a timely manner may result in restrictions from after-school activities.

ID BADGES

Students will be held accountable for wearing the badges that have been distributed. Extra lanyards can be purchased in Tiger Mart, which is open daily during lunches. Once pictures are taken and official badges are distributed, additional badges will cost \$5.

LOCKERS

All grade levels were issued lockers and a combination lock. Backpacks are not allowed in classrooms or in the cafeteria; students need to keep their backpacks in their lockers. Students can carry Chromebooks and notebooks to class in a Chromebook case.

MEDICATIONS ON CAMPUS

As of this year, **ALL MEDICATIONS ON CAMPUS REQUIRE DOCTOR'S ORDERS** in addition to a parent authorization form. This means that **all prescription and over-the-counter medications** require a doctor's order and will not be allowed on campus at all without it. In the past, the prescription label on the bottle served as an MD order but AISD has changed the policy and now requires the MD order. Students are not allowed to self-carry ANY medication without doctor's orders and parent authorization.

Daily medications and/or emergency medications such as inhalers, epipens, seizure or diabetic medications can be dropped off. The medications cannot be accepted without the necessary paperwork completed. You may visit the GMS website at gorzycki.austinschools.org to print and complete all necessary paperwork. DROPPING OFF ITEMS AT SCHOOL

In order to assist students with self-responsibility and to keep classroom disruptions to a minimum, GMS does not make deliveries nor do we contact the student while they are in class to let them know that their item was dropped off. You may tell your student before school that you will be dropping off an item or you can email their teacher. The student will then have to pick it up from the front office. (delivery exceptions are contact lenses or glasses).

PERMIT TO LEAVE SCHOOL EARLY

When students leave school early, written permission from a parent or guardian is required. Please follow these steps:

- 1. The student must bring the note to the front office in the morning to receive a pink slip.
- The student will show the pink slip to the teacher when it is time to leave; the teacher will allow
 the student to go to the front office for parent pick-up. **Without a pink slip, students are not
 allowed to leave class**

3. Parent/guardian(s) must sign the student out in the front office before leaving campus. Please bring your photo ID.
